Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop employing only four people. Total sales for that initial year amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and other components. Through five years of operation, the company had stretched to forty employees and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Today, Cascade is among the top international manufacturers within the material handling industry.

Design and manufacturing of the company's very first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. Throughout the last 60 years, the trade of material handling has developed into a very complex field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade currently continues to grow as the best provider of forklift attachments and various related products. The business feels certain in their capability in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the international market.

Through the nineteen fifties, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and promote its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was constructed in 1956, so as to accommodate all plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's present center of operations. After 15 years of business, total workers reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached nearly 2.3 million dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio a second manufacturing plant was built. 1960 marked Cascade's preliminary move into the international world of the material handling industry while the company recognized interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its production facilities within the U.S. with locations in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Ohio, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade products are made internationally thanks to numerous subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This plant is built to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of 5 companies, including the worldwide best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
