Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizings of hook type blade carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for loads up to 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for Class I is 13 inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted forks could vary by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the blade. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
